

Ordinance No. **118** of 2007

The Borough has determined that certain locations habitually act as public nuisances by playing loud music, engaging in violent activities, i.e., fighting and drunken behavior, requiring multiple police visits and infringing on the rights of other residents.

Disorderly House – dwelling which acts as a common nuisance or disturbance to the neighborhood.

Disorderly Commercial Premises – any premises in which the owner or patrons exhibit drunken behavior, obscene language or conduct, including loud noises, fighting, or a combination of this.
