



# Concrete Tire Stop Placement Parking Restrictions



## Project Status:

We are very sorry, but we are going to ask you to move your vehicles one last time. Our contractor believed he would be able to install the concrete tire barriers back into place without having you move your vehicles. He was not able to do so. The barriers are just too heavy to be lifted without the assistance of a tractor with fork lifts.

## Parking Restrictions:

On **Wednesday, September 16th at 7:00am**, area **"A"** (Pennsbury Blvd. South from Double carport area to Pennsview Court) will close to all parking in front of the buildings. All cars will need to be removed from the white lined parking spaces by 7:00am. The area is marked in **blue** on the map below. We will allow you to parallel park your vehicle across the street, on the opposite side of the road. Parking in front of the buildings can resume as soon as the concrete tire barriers have been installed. This affects parking in front of Buildings 11, 12 and 13. Watch for the "No Parking" signs.

On **Thursday, September 17th at 7:00am**, area **"B"** Pennsbury Blvd. North from Pennsview Court to the stop sign near Countryview Court will close to all parking in front of the buildings. All cars need to be removed from the white lined parking spaces by 7:00am. The area is marked in **yellow** on the map below. We will allow you to parallel park your vehicle across, on the opposite side of the road. Parking in front of the buildings can resume as soon as the concrete tire barriers have been installed. This affects parking in front of buildings 17 and 18. Watch for the "No Parking" signs.

*Parallel parking on the opposite side of the road is permitted.*

*Parking in spaces in front of the buildings will resume as soon as their concrete barrier has been installed.*

*Please have your vehicle moved back into your normal parking space by 5pm.*
