

2021 PET REGISTRATION EXTENDED



By law, all pets are required to be registered **annually** with the Borough and all dogs are also required to be registered **annually** with Allegheny County. Penalties for non-compliance include monetary fines.

Each year, the Borough waives the \$25.00 registration fee during the month of January.

Due to the pandemic, for this year only, we will extend the fee waiver period until **February 28, 2021**. Beginning Monday, March 1, 2021, the \$25.00 fee will again be in effect. As is standard policy, the fee will be waived for any new pets that are registered within 30 days of arriving in the Borough during the year.

Due to the pandemic, for 2021 only, pet owners may request their annual pet registration by emailing a scan or jpg photo of their current **VETERINARIAN RABIES CERTIFICATE** to **boropv@comcast.net** or placing the original certificate in an envelope and dropping it in the silver box outside the Borough office door.

Please designate: "PET REGISTRATION" on the envelope or email subject line.

Information required: Your Name, Address, Phone Numbers, Type of Pet, Pet's Breed, Pet's Color(s), and Pet's Name.

A 2021 Pet Registration Tag will be issued to you to attach to your pet's collar. The 2021 tag will be delivered to your home along with a paper permit and your original rabies certificate.

-  Your dog **must be leashed** at all times when outdoors.
-  Walk your dog in the grassy areas **away from the units, flowers and shrubs.**

Please do not place pet waste bags outside your unit in the shrub beds. All pet waste bags must be placed in a dumpster immediately!

We have many residents of all ages in the neighborhood who walk or jog year-round, as well as many dog walkers. As a result, cleaning up pet waste, for sanitary reasons, is a must throughout the year; not only in warm weather. That's also why leashing dogs for the safety of people, as well as the animals themselves is important too – there is a danger from vehicles and, let's face it, all dogs don't like each other.
